Dear Residents,

In August, we informed you that due to restrictions issued by Executive Order of the Governor that Public Comment during City Meetings would only be permitted online via Zoom. We have found this method to be inconvenient for residents in terms of public participation.

Effective immediately, residents will be allowed to offer public comments and/or questions in person during the public comment portion of the meeting agenda. However, by Executive Order of the Governor (Executive Order 2020-176), room capacity is still limited to 10 individuals. If you wish to participate in the public comment portion of a meeting, you will be allowed into Council Chambers one at a time during this portion of the meeting. We ask residents to please wait in the hallway outside of Council Chambers for their opportunity to speak. Facemasks are required for entry into City Hall and six-foot social distancing requirements are in effect.

City Council meetings will be streamed live on Facebook, the same as it was before the pandemic. The City will no longer utilize Zoom for public meetings. We remain committed to operating safely and as transparently as possible.
