

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT ON STOEFLLET STREET BETWEEN**  
**FRYER DRIVE AND SOUTH GIBRALTAR ROAD**

**The City of Gibraltar will be undertaking the replacement of the pavement on Stoefflet Street between Fryer drive and South Gibraltar Road on or around August 5, 2019 with an anticipated completion date by October 15, 2019. The project consists of the removal of the existing pavement and replacement with new pavement including curbs.**

**When will the work start?**

Weather permitting; the Contractor will begin work on approximately August 5, 2019. The contractor (Gibraltar Construction, Inc.) will start by removing the existing pavement. Grading, sub-drains installation and curbing will be undertaken afterward. Once the concrete curbs are cured the new pavement will be placed followed by restoration.

**Where will I park?** On accessible driveways only. Effective **MONDAY AUG. 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2019** parking will **NOT** be allowed on Stoefflet St. throughout the duration of the project. We understand parking will be the greatest impact of this job, and apologize for the inconvenience, however it is unavoidable in order to accomplish the reconstruction.

**Will the street be open during construction?**

One-way traffic will be maintained during the majority of the work on the project. Intermittent closures will occur during pavement removal and paving operation. Notifications will be distributed to alert homeowners of upcoming closures.

**What about police, fire and rescue access to my home?**

The Police and Fire Departments are both aware the project's impact on traffic. The Contractor will make every effort to maintain emergency access to your home.

**What will happen to my US mail delivery?**

Mail boxes will be removed and replaced in kind to allow the work to proceed, and temporary mail boxes will be placed in a cluster near the intersection of Stoefflet St. and S. Gibraltar Rd.

**How will our trash pick up be handled?**

The City's solid waste contractor will be picking up your trash on your regularly scheduled day, between 7:00 and 8:00 a.m. The street contractor will move your trash to the accessible side of the street, however we ask that you bag your trash when the street on your side of the street is not accessible to avoid the contractor's personnel having to move the large "toter" carts across the void where the street is removed. **Your help in this matter would be greatly appreciated.**

**What will happen to my sprinkler/other utilities?**

The Contractor will protect utility crossings and sprinkler systems and will repair those impacted during construction. **Your help in marking these utilities/sprinkler systems would be greatly appreciated.**

**Who do I call if I have a question or if problems arise during construction?**

We encourage you to call our engineering consultant, C.E. Raines Co., directly with all construction related questions or problems at (734) 285-7510. Please ask the operator to direct you to Bill Bettendorf of the Construction Department and indicate that you are calling regarding the Stoeplet Street project in the City of Gibraltar. You may also speak directly to the onsite inspector who will be glad to discuss your concerns and answer any questions you may have.

**Will my driveway be impacted?**

Possibly. The intent of this project is to minimize any disturbance of driveways, however, there is a possibility some driveways will require repair once the street is removed. Any pavement removals at a driveway will be replaced "in-kind".
